PRIVACY NOTICE

pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR)

1. Data controller

The data controller is ANIMAMBIENTE ODV, with registered office at C.da Rioleto, Cleto (CS), Italy, Tax Code 96055230781. For privacy-related communications, the Association can be contacted at: ANIMAMBIENTE@PEC.ANIMAMBIENTE.ORG.

2. Personal data processed

When managing relationships with members, volunteers, membership applicants, supporters and people who contact the Association, the Association may process identification and contact data, including full name, place and date of birth, tax code, residential address, telephone number and email address. Occupation is collected only if provided voluntarily. The Association does not intend to collect special categories of personal data, unless required by law or strictly necessary for specific activities and the relevant processing is lawful.

3. Purposes and legal bases

- managing membership applications and membership relationships, including maintaining the Members' Register;
- organising and carrying out the Association's institutional and volunteering activities;
- calling meetings and sending communications concerning Association activities;
- complying with applicable legal obligations, including those concerning the Third Sector, administration, accounting and volunteer insurance;
- establishing, exercising or defending the Association's legal claims.

Depending on the circumstances, processing is based on taking pre-contractual steps or performing the membership relationship, compliance with legal obligations, or the Association's legitimate interest in managing and protecting its activities. Where consent is required, it will be requested separately.

4. Provision of data

Providing the data needed to process a membership application and manage the membership relationship is necessary for those purposes. Failure to provide such data may make it impossible to assess the application or manage the relationship. Optional data may be omitted without affecting the application.

5. Processing methods and retention

Data are processed using paper-based and, where necessary, electronic means, in accordance with the principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency, data minimisation and security. The membership document states that paper records are kept at the Association's premises or another secure location designated by the Board. Access is restricted to Board members and formally authorised persons. Data are retained for the duration of the relationship and thereafter for the period necessary to comply with legal obligations and protect the Association's rights.

6. Recipients and disclosure

Data are not publicly disclosed or transferred to third parties for commercial purposes. Where necessary and within the relevant roles, data may be disclosed to insurance companies, public bodies, professionals appointed for administrative or tax matters, and competent authorities where required by law. The Association does not envisage transfers of personal data to countries outside the European Economic Area or to international organisations; if such a transfer becomes necessary, the safeguards

required by the GDPR will be applied.

7. Data subject rights

Data subjects may exercise the rights provided for by Articles 15–22 GDPR, including access, rectification, erasure where applicable, restriction of processing, objection and, where applicable, data portability. Where processing is based on consent, consent may be withdrawn at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out before withdrawal. 8. Right to lodge a complaint

Data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority (Garante per la protezione dei dati personali), as the competent supervisory authority, if they believe that the processing infringes applicable law.

9. Automated decision-making

The Association does not carry out processing based on automated decision-making, including profiling, which produces legal effects or similarly significantly affects the data subject.
